

### Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1

Throughout EYFS and KS1, children should be exposed to some basic Spanish vocabulary where appropriate. These words should also be available in the learning environment in KS1. Daily Dashboard and classroom routines to include: basic greetings, colours, numbers 1-10, days of the week and basic weather. Vocabulary to link to theme planning where relevant.

### **Key Stage 2**

Planning is taken from the Twinkl Spanish units of work as follows. Fluency units should be taught through the Daily Dashboard curriculum throughout the year. Lessons will take place twice each week. Minimum of 15 minutes x2 weekly sessions. Session 1 to be fluency based and introduce new vocabulary through games and interaction. Session 2 to involve recalling rehearsed vocabulary from the previous lesson, recording vocabulary and move on to producing written phrases and/or sentences. Children to record their work in one Language Passport Book throughout their time in KS2. Books to have unit overview front cover at the start of the work and assessment jigsaw. This should be coloured in using RAG at the end of each session.
