In Geography, we will be looking at Africa and the different animals and landmarks that are found there.

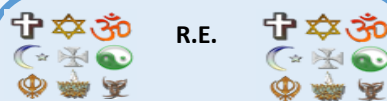


Science

In science, we will be looking at all four seasons. We will be identifying key features of each season and also be able to compare each season against another.



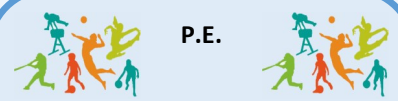
R.E.

In PE, we will be looking at different types of games. Our PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday.



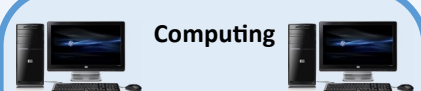
Music
