Geography

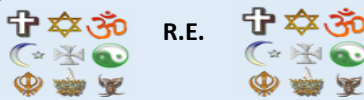
We will be learning about key landmarks from each country, mountain ranges, rivers, volcanoes and earthquakes. We will also look at key historical figures from each country and their social impact.

Science



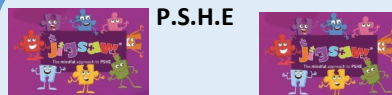
Micro-organisms and Electricity

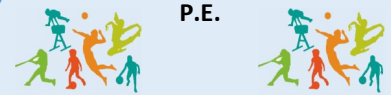
R.E.

P.S.H.E

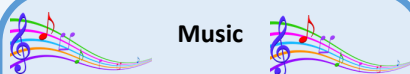
In P.S.H.E, we will be learning from the unit called *Being me in my world* from the scheme Jigsaw.

Our PE days are Monday and Tuesday. Please ensure appropriate, plain-ish clothing is worn.



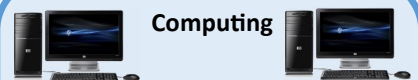
Music
