Learning

Lessons should be taught in short sessions to introduce vocabulary initially. Later in the week, vocabulary should be revisited and written tasks should be completed.

How often will the previous learning be reviewed?

Supporting assessment:

Structured assessments using the jigsaw summary.
These should be displayed in MFL books before the lessons and coloured in using RAG at the end of each lesson. The jigsaw pieces also need to be dated. This will help teachers understand whether children are secure before moving on.

How will you ensure someone has caught up if they are absent?

Not only do they provide an opportunity to communicate more effectively with others, they also help children to understand what it is to be a global citizen. This includes the importance of tolerance and understanding, which is crucial knowledge in today's world.

Subject leader to consider next:

- to be checking into lessons and observing good practice.
- Are the jigsaw assessments grids being used by the children and staff to inform catch up sessions.
- Ask staff how comfortable they are teaching Spanish and whether this impacts on the amount of time they spend teaching it.
